

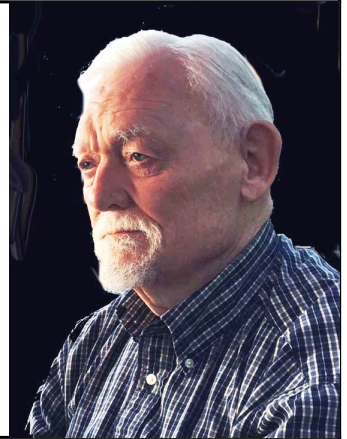
Suzanne Burke

- Asian Pacific Children's Fund board member



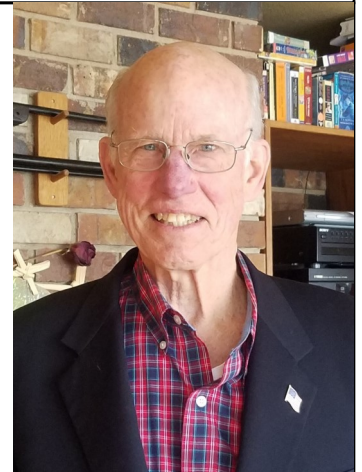
Col. Clark H. Summers, USAR (ret.), PhD
